I predict that *The One and Only Ivan*, 2012 has a gorilla named Ivan and a baby elephant named Ruby that live in a circus. My first reason to predict this is because on the cover they are on wooden floorboards and the wall behind them has jungle wallpaper. When circuses were allowed to have exotic animals they often had wallpaper to crudely mimic the animals habitat which explains why there are also floorboards. Another piece of evidence is the font on the cover as it is gold and fancy and circuses often have gold and fancy letters to attract people. I think that the gorilla is Ivan because it is a male with its silver back. The cover also has the name Ivan and if there is a name on the cover then there is often the character that has the name on it too. Ruby is probably the elephant because her name showed up multiple times on the same page as the baby elephant. I think Ruby is a baby because she is smaller than the gorilla.
